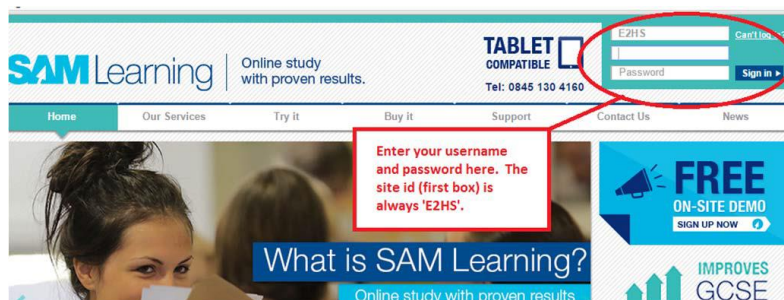
Introducing SAM Learning

Access details

Students are able to access the service at anytime and anywhere. It is available to them in school in the library and in homework spaces, but also at home and their local library. All they need to do is visit the website and enter their unique login details.

User ID	Date of birth followed by two initials: first name and then last name. Example John Smith born on 23rd March 2001, it would be '230301js'
Password	Initially the same as the User ID. Students are encouraged to change their password to something difficult to guess.

It is advised that students keep a record of their login details in their planners.

How to get involved

All students will received a help sheet telling them how to use SAM Learning and you might wish to ask them how it works. Teachers may set specific tasks for your child to complete. However, your child can log on at any time and complete tasks independently. When homework is set on SAM Learning it will be marked which means that you can easily monitor the progress of your child.
