

## Year 7 pupil Catch-up 2017-18

### 1. How much catch-up premium allocation was received for 2017-18?

Year 7 literacy and numeracy catch-up funding is provided to fund interventions for the children who enter Year 7 with attainment levels below their peers. In the academic year 2017-18 the Year 7 catch-up funding for Haggerston School was £13,041.

At Haggerston School, we identified pupils who achieved below 100 in their KS2 SATS in Reading, Maths or both. The school also continues to support the progress of Y7 catch-up pupils when they are in Y8 to ensure that gaps are closed within KS3.
