3. How did the spending make a difference to the attainment of pupils who attracted the premium in 2018-19?

At three periods across the academic year, data is collected and analysed to identify pupil underachievement, including closing the gap in the attainment of catch-up pupils. Pupils not making expected progress are targeted swiftly for intervention as part of a whole cycle of re-teaching. In addition, in-class intervention will be targeted to address gaps through timely live feedback by teachers.
