##### **Brexit event for Hackney's European citizens**

Hackney Council is holding an event for the borough's European citizens, people who work with them and local businesses concerned about Brexit.

It will feature advice stalls and sessions about Brexit-related issues and applying for Settled Status; an opportunity for people to share and celebrate their stories; and addresses from the Mayor of Hackney, Philip Glanville, and others.

On hand will be:

- Hackney Citizens Advice - general advice and applying for Settled Status
- Migrant Help - general advice and information sessions
- Praxis - help for vulnerable people to apply for Settled Status
- London Growth Hub - providing 1-2-1 support for businesses
- A range of government advice materials
- Council's registrars - support scanning documentation
- Hackney Museum - project recording stories and celebrating heritage

There will also be opportunities for people to have a tour of the Town Hall, and attendees will be able to pick up #HackneyLovesYou badges, flags and posters.

The event will be a drop-in style. Tickets are free and won't be requested on the door. However, registering will help us anticipate numbers and also means we can update attendees with more specific timings nearer the day. Refreshments will be provided.
