Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 10 and 12 students have returned to school this week for tutorials with staff. This is in preparation for re-starting lessons next week. We have been really impressed by how sensible and responsible students have been when in school and their understanding of the importance of social distancing and hygiene. We are beginning to plan for different scenarios in September but await guidance from the government about the specific arrangements. As soon as we know more, I will be in touch with details.

We are also running webinars over the coming week to ensure parents are fully informed about what is happening and about the school. We are adapting to make sure we can offer creative alternatives and are planning for an extended transition phase in September.

I am pleased to let you know that we are fully staffed for next academic year. At this time of year we also have to say goodbye to some staff, who have all made a really valued contribution to Haggerston School. Many are moving on to promotions and this is a great indication that the school is fostering leaders for the future. The full list of leavers and new staff is outlined below. We have been fortunate to recruit a number of excellent, well qualified teachers this year. As a result of our increasing popularity as a school, we have had secure pupil numbers in the sixth form and Year 7 for several years. The additional funding that comes as a result of this has also been put to good use and we have been able to recruit more staff than we are losing allowing us to add capacity in key areas of the school.
