Nor was Racism,

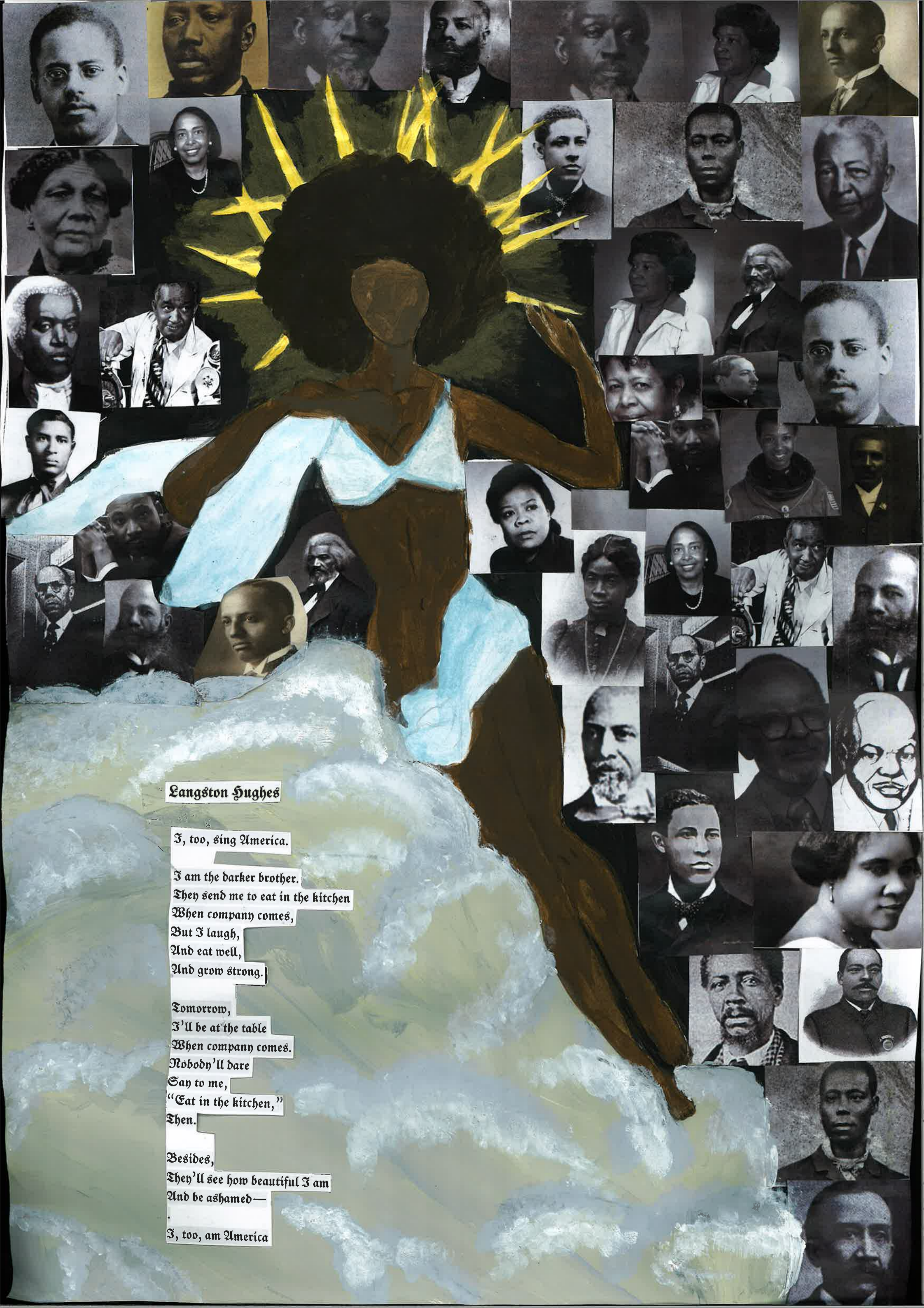
It was our mindsets
