The STEM Learning London Team have launched a STEM Challenge with the Civil Service STEM Ambassadors (please see attached PDF) focused on the environment and sustainability. They are inviting year 9 & 10 students to imagine themselves as scientists and policy makers responsible for ensuring that resources are managed in a sustainable and carbon neutral way in the year 2050. Teams of 3 to 5 students will be asked to provide their 'vision of a carbon neutral day in 2050' focusing on one of three key areas: food production, space exploration, and housing. Each school will be able to enter a maximum of 135 students for participation.

Prizes for the winning team will include certificates signed by Government Chief Scientific Adviser Sir Patrick Vallance and £25 amazon vouchers for each member of the winning team.
