### **Gov.UK - Student Finance - application service open for the 22/23 academic year – Apply now**

Full-time undergraduate students in England are being encouraged to apply now for student finance, for the 22/23 academic year. The Student Loans Company (SLC) expects approximately 1.5 million full-time, undergraduate students to apply for funding this year and the advice is to get applications in early. Students in England can apply for Tuition Fee Loans to cover their fees and Maintenance Loans to help with living costs. By applying before the deadline (20 May 2022 for new students and 24 June 2022 for returning students) students can ensure they will have their finance in place for the start of term. Even if they are unsure on what course they will be doing or what university they will be attending, SLC is still encouraging students to apply now.
