# MESSAGE FROM HEADTEACHER

#### Ms Emmerson

Dear Parents/Carers

Happy New Year! We look forward to welcoming students back to school this week.

I am sure you will have seen the news reports about very high levels of Covid infection in the community and that the government has consequently mandated mask wearing in classrooms and communal areas for three weeks while the impact of school return on infection levels is assessed. Mask wearing will be reviewed on 26 January and schools will receive updated guidance then. Please ensure your child returns to school this week with a re-usable mask. If you have previously written to us to let us know your child is exempt, this will still apply. If your child's circumstances have changed or they are in Year 7, please let us know if they are exempt from mask wearing by writing to your child's Head of Year. They will then be issued with an exemption card. I understand this is a change some parents will be concerned about. However, the government priority is to keep schools open this term and this means taking all measures to reduce transmission in school. We are assured that the decision on face coverings will be a short lived one.

In addition, we are following the advice of the Hackney public health team to run assemblies online for this period to reduce the frequency of groups of students gathering together. We will continue to balance the risk of covid transmission against the need to ensure continuity of normal educational experiences for students so will reinstate face to face assemblies as soon as possible. We will run celebration assemblies (some of which were cancelled at the end of term) in a different and adapted way but students will still get recognition and certificates for their achievements.

Testing continues to play a vital role in controlling the spread of Covid in schools. Testing all students will help reduce transmission after a period of social mixing over the school holidays and hopefully enable a disruption free start to the new year. All students should be ready to attend school for testing this week ahead of their return to the classroom. After this initial test, pupils should continue to home-test twice weekly, in line with government guidelines.

#### Consent to testing

Many of you have already indicated your consent, or otherwise, to on-site testing. If you have not done this or wish to change your consent, please complete this <u>Consent Form</u> by the end of the day today.

#### **Recent Covid**

The government guidance has now changed and students are encouraged to participate in the testing process even if they have had a recent covid infection within the past 90 days. Please use the <u>Consent Form</u> to indicate if this applies to your child.

#### **Testing schedule**

Please see the table below for the testing schedule and ensure your child is ready to attend during their slot and to return on their assigned date. Students should enter school via reception for their testing slot and do not need to wear uniform.

#### **Self Isolation**

Guidance has changed on self isolation requirements. If your child has tested positive for Covid 19, they must isolate for ten days. However, their isolation period can be reduced to 7 days if they have two consecutive negative tests, 24 hours apart, on days 6 and 7 of the isolation period and they no longer have a high temperature. Please inform us if this is the case so that we are aware of the reason why your child is returning to school before the end of the normal isolation period. We will not routinely set work for students who test positive with Covid 19 as many need this time to recover fully from the infection. However, if your child is asymptomatic or well enough to do some work at home, you may request work from your child's head of year.

Many thanks for your co-operation with the measures outlined above. I hope they will go some way to ensure as smooth a return to school as possible for students.
