## DPR - one page report

- You will see on the report that most subjects (with the exception of PE and Creative Art) used written assessments to determine percentages for each student.
- Subjects then decided on the minimum percentages students needed to score to be 'On' track.

## DPR - progress reporting

- Each year every subject has a set of objectives that will be covered
- For parents, this lets you know what is being covered and what needs to be revised for assessments
- This is supported by the knowledge organisers for each term
- These are judged three times a year
- By the end of the year we aim for all objectives to be green/secure

## DPR - progress reporting

U	UNABLE TO ASSESS: The objective has been covered but evidence has not yet been gathered to award a judgement.
E	EMERGING: Student has no or little understanding of the objective covered.
D	DEVELOPING: Student has some understanding of the objective and requires support.
С	CONSOLIDATING: Student has a good understanding of the objective and can produce work independently, but may need more practice to show secure understanding
S	SECURED: Student has a secure understanding of the objectives and they are able to demonstrate this independently in an assessment.
N	Not Covered
