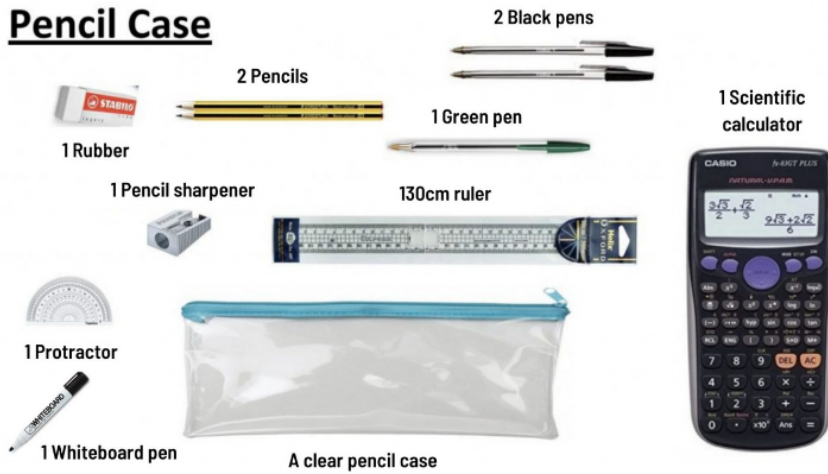


### **Top tip for starting secondary school.**
